Homelessness causes devastating personal harm, significantly impacts on the community and affects all aspects of an individual's life and wellbeing. Homelessness is an issue that is not going away on its own and as a society we can't afford to ignore it.

This Seminar is for community workers and others who **don't work in a housing role but who may assist clients with housing issues** as part of their role. Workers will be better informed on how they can best support a client down the different paths to stable accommodation including support to access private rental or maintaining an existing at risk tenancy.

- Have a greater understanding of products and financial assistance available for people experiencing or at risk of homelessness
- Have an understanding of specialist homelessness services and their role
- Be better able to assist clients experiencing or at risk of homelessness
- Understand how tenancy services can assist in saving at risk tenancies
