'While other sectors faced downturns, the demand for community support dramatically increased as need and disadvantage escalated in areas such as homelessness, mental health support, and domestic and family violence.'

'Many providers including those in disability, aged care, and family support organisations were extremely creative in coming up with new COVID-safe ways to ensure their participants were not left isolated during the pandemic. It is this ingenuity that needs to be recognised and celebrated,' Eleonore Johansson, Chair of the Community Industry Group Board explained. 'It's time that the hard work of the community services workforce in the Illawarra and Southern NSW is publicly appreciated and rewarded.'

The nomination process is quick and simple. Categories include 'A Brilliant Idea', 'Team Effort', 'Collaboration', 'Transformation' and 'Above & Beyond'.
