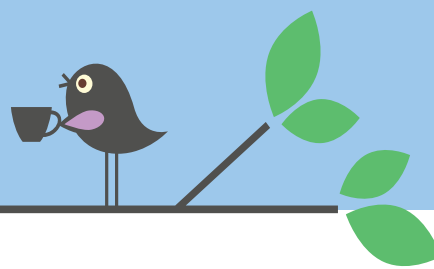

We will facilitate reconnection events which will include a free mentoring program amongst not for profit organisations in the region.

Participants will be invited to attend at least one launch session and will be given access to:

- Supported peer matching and meetings
- Graduation and networking events
- Guidance and advice from our expert facilitators

External Supervision Support

External supervision support will be available by expression of interest. Participation will involve a one hour session per month, for up to 12 months.
